

The New York City Police Department is seeking to hire service-oriented individuals for the positions of Traffic Enforcement Agent and School Safety Agent. These positions offer an opportunity to serve your community, increase public safety, and enjoy a generous benefits package for you and your family.

Many of our auxiliary police officers possess the qualities that would make them ideal candidates for these titles. They have volunteered their time to provide a public service to the citizens of New York City. These auxiliary officers have exhibited a desire to serve the community and we want to ensure that they are apprised of all of the available career paths within the Department.

Traffic Enforcement Agents are responsible to keep both pedestrian and vehicular traffic safe and moving throughout the City of New York. Entry-level Traffic Enforcement Agents patrol an assigned area in order to enforce laws, rules and regulations relating to movement, parking, stopping and standing of vehicles. These duties include issuing summonses, testifying in court and administrative hearings, preparing reports, reporting on traffic conditions and other related tasks.

Becoming a Traffic Enforcement Agent provides not only an opportunity to serve the community, but also offers a competitive salary, benefits, and retirement plan. Agents may potentially earn over \$38,000 after one year of service, not including overtime. While overtime is not guaranteed, many Traffic Enforcement Agents earn significantly more income by working additional hours and tours of duty. Full health benefits are offered immediately upon hiring, at a very low cost to the participant.

School Safety Agents provide security and ensure the safety of students, faculty and visitors in the New York City Public School buildings and surrounding premises. The duties of this title include screening school entrances for unauthorized entrants and items, rendering aid to sick or injured persons, requesting assistance of other emergency personnel, diffusing and resolving conflicts between students, maintaining related records, and other duties pertaining to school safety and security.

NYPD School Safety Agents are rewarded for their service to the city's school children with a generous benefits and retirement plan. The starting salary for the position is over \$32,000 per year, increasing to over \$46,000 after 7 years. School Safety Agents also have the opportunity to supplement their earnings substantially with overtime pay (Overtime is not guaranteed). Full health benefits are offered immediately upon hiring, at a very low cost to the participant.

There are various levels of assignment that both Traffic Enforcement Agents and School Safety Agents can attain through promotion. Promotions via both merit and civil-service examination offer increased job variety, greater responsibility, and higher salary. The Department also offers the Promotion to Police Officer Exam, which is an opportunity to join our uniformed ranks, to Traffic and School Safety Agents several times per year.

The first step to joining the NYPD as either a Traffic Enforcement Agent or School Safety Agent is to take our exam. The enclosed posters may be distributed to auxiliary officers to inform them about these career opportunities.
